

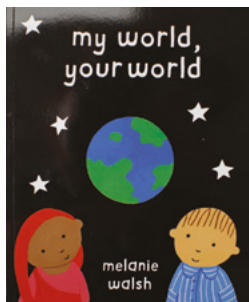
Children's literature

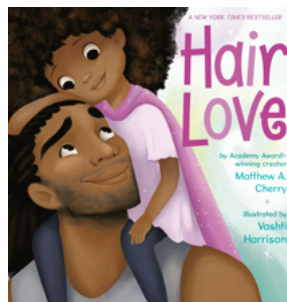

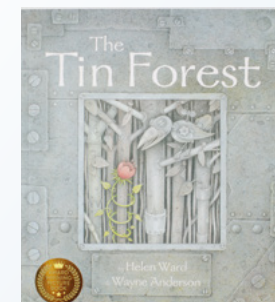

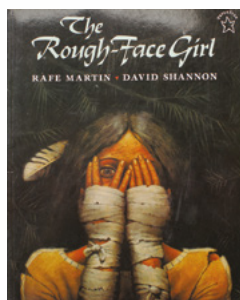

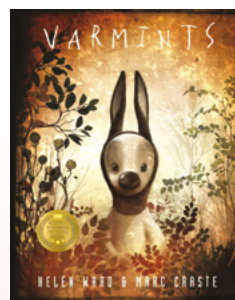

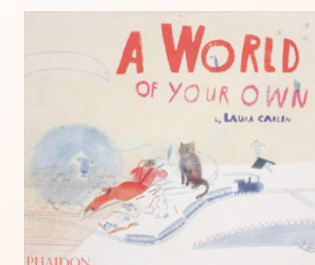
